What is the 'm' Technique?

The 'm' Technique is a registered method of touch suitable for the very fragile or those wanting a gentle healing treatment. It is a series of stroking movements performed in a set sequence at a set pressure.

The 'm' Technique can have a measurable therapeutic effect on:

Fear HeadachesAnxiety InsomniaGrief Migraines

Anger Sprains and strains
 Acute & Chronic Pain Low immune function

Chronic Fatigue Stress

Depression High Blood Pressure



Touch is one of the most basic forms of communication yet many of us are too afraid to touch those who need it most. The 'm' Technique is simple enough to teach a child, yet it evokes a rapid and profound relaxing effect.

The 'm' Technique course runs over 2 days and students are required to complete two written case studies and submit them within 6 months of the course for certification. The 'm' Technique is registered in the USA and UK and certificates are issued from the UK. The course has been approved by the Allied Health Professions Council of SA.
